Following these discussions, please be advised that subject to the relevant approvals, Tudor Grange Academies Trust has been identified as the preferred Trust for the Nuneaton Academy to transfer to. This will be subject to the approval of the Regional Director following the Advisory Board meeting to be held on the 22nd of September. It is expected that the transfer will take place in January 2023.


